1 Valorisation Report

During the WYRED kick-off meeting held in Salamanca, the 2-3 of November, 2016, the overall approach to valorisation was explained and shared with the other partners by Oxfam Italia, the leader of the work package, (for more details please see the power point presentation *annex_1 WYRED_WP_Valorisation_OIT_KoM_2-3_nov_16_SN*). In the following months, Oxfam worked on developing the WYRED Valorisation plan (see annex_2 *WYRED_WP8_D.8.1_Valorisation Plan_1st year_version1.2*) with clearly defined objectives, project tangible and intangible products and targets to address in relation to the products. The plan is structured in two parts: dissemination and exploitation strategy.

First of all, the intention expressed in Valorisation Plan was to establish a valorisation team / board where each partner is represented and which will be leaded by the leader of the work package in order to work on, to steer and to monitor together the valorisation activities.



The WYRED **logo** has been designed at the beginning of the project. All partners have provided feedback on the logo, and the partnership decided on the final, official project logo to be used. The logo represents the youth participatory culture.

As described in the Valorisation Plan the news publications follow a specific workflow. The website has a News section and the publication of news in the main page blog is coordinated by USAL. Moreover, the website has also 7 Local Blogs sections where the local team publish news about the activities they are carrying out. Each blog is managed by a valorization contact person, who has the responsibility of checking and publishing the posts. The contents that partners have wanted to publish on the main blog have been translated into English. This assures visibility of the activities that the consortium is carrying out in different countries also to the international public.






2. Examples of WYRED Local blogs

In the reporting-period the WYRED website main blog has published 20 news and 52 news on the partners' local blogs therefore totaling **72 news items**.

Statistical analysis of the project website and social media pages serves partners as a guidance for further activities. The main indicators of interest are:

Page views: number of web pages requested and viewed by the user.





There have been 5,849 page views over the period between February 2017 and January 2018.

The page describing the project, WYRED Project – networked Youth Research for Empowerment in the Digital Society, has totalised the vast majority of views (2,414, accounting for the 41.27% of the total), followed by the homepage (viewed 338 times) and the announcement of the WYRED Slogan Competition (viewed 244 times). As it is shown above, most views occurred between February and April 2017, were near zero over the summer and started to grow back by October 2017.

- Visits or sessions: number of visits to the WYRED website made by users. There have been 2,554 visits to the website from 1,568 users, with an average of 2.29 pages viewed per session.
- Location of the users: the countries that users have accessed the most from. Unsurprisingly, Spain has the largest number of users (614 sessions between February 2017 and January 2018, accounting for 24,04% of the overall sessions), followed by UK (406 sessions, 15,90% of the total), Turkey (303, 11,86%) and Italy (251, 9.83%).
- Unique visitors: number of single users that have visited the site. There have been 3,867 unique page views over the period between February 2017 and January 2018, with a percentage of approx. 66% users leaving the website after being redirected to it.
- **Time spent:** time spent in minutes and seconds while navigating or viewing the pages of the site. The average time spent on each page was 00:01:54 and the average duration of a session was 00:02:27.

The Facebook statistics provide us with data on the people following the page, disaggregated by age and gender:

- 72% of followers are female, whereas only 23% are male.
- 51% of the total users' range in age from 25 to 44.
- 15% are aged between 45 and 54 years old.
- Users between 55 and 64 years old are mostly female. Available data on male users in the same age group show little homogeneity.

33 posts have been published in the reporting period and, with regard to the total views of the page, they reached their highest point in mid-November 2017, following the launch of the online platform and a first attempt to engage the target groups. 


The Instagram profile has been visited 48 times and has 51 followers. 2 stories and 18 other publications are currently featured on it.

The 15 tweets published and 124 retweets have appeared in the timelines of the 59 followers 5.075 times, for a total amount of 65 likes, with an upward trend in the last 28 days. The newsletter template has been developed through Mailchimp programme. The Valorisation Plan states that the Newsletter should be produced on a four-monthly base as long as the newsletter is automatically generated by the website news section: the news should be collected and generated through the website, taking information and news from local and general blogs. Considering the nature of the activities, it was not possible to collect a sufficient amount of news to create the national newsletters. In the last weeks, the consortium as a whole has made remarkable efforts to increase the number of publications on the website and we forecast at least 4 newsletter editions in the following weeks.

Besides dissemination tools, also monitoring tools for valorisation have been defined.

2 Conclusions

What we can see and conclude from the report is that:

- The main product we have disseminated so far is the project itself (the activities, news, web, promotional materials).
- From the available data, it is not easy for us to have a clear breakdown of the reached targets. In order to have relevant data we need to start collecting some additional qualitative information from currently undistinguished groups (participants, etc.) or quantitative information.
- The consortium should increase the number of inputs and the contents to be uploaded in the local blogs website section because, accordingly to the workflow, each important dissemination action (newsletters, Facebook posts, Tweets, Instagram posts etc) is generated from the contents uploaded on the partners' blog. We should increase the partners' commitment to report the project's activities in terms of news and involve the beneficiaries in the news reporting and drafting.
- The consortium should take action in order to promote social media between the project's beneficiaries.
