

## **CLIL in Poland:**

### **Report prepared by Ministry of Education 2005-2006 “Language Education in Poland”**

There are bilingual classes on each level of education in Poland, but majority of them are in Liceum ( 16-19 years), Gymnasium ( 12-16 years) and primary schools in classes between IV and VI ( 10-12 years) . The second language in those schools could be: English, German, French, Spanish and Italian.

There are 39 bilingual schools with English language, 35 with German, 7 with French, 5 with Spanish and 1 with Italian.

Usually CLIL is offered on the 2-3 subject in the school. The most popular subjects with CLIL: mathematics, physics, chemistry, biology, common history, geography and ICT. The CLIL is forbidden by the law in Poland of the following lessons: Polish language, History of Poland, Geography of Poland.

There is possibility to pass final exam for secondary school of the bilingual subject ( the whole report only in Polish)
